1. It was agreed to invite Andy Anderson of Third Revolution Projects, the consultant for the proposed Solar PV Farm at Bryngolwg, to the next meeting. (Cllr. Evans declared an interest).
2. It was agreed that there will be no charge for residents who wish to place a memorial bench in Rhigos Cemetery.
3. It was agreed that allotment rental fees will remain the same for this year.
4. It was proposed, seconded and agreed by all to purchase a Queen's Jubilee memento for every household in Rhigos.
5. It was agreed that residents of the Bryn can borrow 2 tables from the community centre for their Jubilee party. A refundable deposit of £5.00 will be charged.
